**1) ENTRIES:** P/OP - \$200.00; T/OT - \$190.00; PT/OPT - \$180.00; E/OE - \$170.00.

*HST, drug, ambulance, and "Building Ontario One Event at a Time" fees included in entry.* All levels please add \$10 CE Levy. **Note: a photocopy of all current memberships MUST accompany entry.** Failure to include will incur an additional \$10.00 incomplete charge! **Completed entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$30.00 late fee, if accepted. No exceptions to this charge.**

Refunds: Before CD, less \$30.00 administration fee. After CD, no refunds. Cheques made payable to Lane's End Horse Trials. NO post-dated cheques. Negative Coggins dated within previous 6 months required if stabling.

**2) TIME SCHEDULE:** August 18 – noon. Office and course open. August 19 – 8:00AM – dressage, 10:00 – show jumping and cross country. Start times available from the secretary between 6PM and 9PM August 16, on-line at

**3) OFFICIALS:** TD: Peggy Hambly. Stadium: Kellie Towers, Dressage Judges: Peta Christen, Yulia Novitskaya CD/CB: Hugh Morshead. Stadium design: Caroline Morshead

**4) STABLING:** \$50.00 per night. Limited – enter early for stalls available on site. Initial bedding provided. Additional stabling within 15 minutes. Negative Coggins required dated within previous 6 months.

**5) DRESSAGE:** OP/P: Test 2; OT/T: Test 1; OPT/PT: Test 1; OE/E: Test 2. P/OP 20 x 60 m, all other divisions 20 x 40 m. Sand and grass rings.

**6) CROSS COUNTRY:** P 2650m @ 520 mpm; T 2350m @ 450 mpm; PT 2100m @ 400 mpm; E 1900m @ 350 mpm. Solid inviting courses with new fences added and course changes. Excellent footing and good galloping over varied terrain. Rolling hills, woods, water complex. **Please Note: Entry Cross Country will now be timed and penalized**

**7) AWARDS:** Ribbons to 8th place and prizes/prize money as arranged.

**9) DIRECTIONS:** From Lindsay/Highway 7 east. Take County Road 36 to Bobcaygeon. Exit left onto Duke Street – becomes County Road 8. First sideroad out of village turn right (north) onto Cosh's Road. 3.5 km to farm. From Fenelon Falls take County Road 8 east towards Bobcaygeon approx 14 km. Turn left (north) onto Cosh's Road. 3.5 km to farm. Signs posted.
