- 1) ENTRIES:** OI- \$235, P-\$220 T-\$210, PT -\$200, E -\$190 PE -\$180. *HST, drug, ambulance, and "Building Ontario One Event at a Time" fees included in entry.* All levels please add \$10 CE Levy. **Note: a photocopy of all current memberships MUST accompany entry. Completed entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$30.00 late fee.** REFUNDS: Before Sept 28, refund less \$30 administration fee with medical certificate; after Sept 28 no refunds. **Cheques made payable to Woodwind Farm.** NO post dated cheques. Riders require Number holders for Cross Country. Bridle tag numbers provided. Organizers reserve the right to add, delete, reschedule or cancel divisions, times, days as entries warrant.
- 2) TIME SCHEDULE:** Sat Oct 6, 3pm - courses and office open. Sun, Oct 7 OI, OP, P, OT: ,T, PT, OPT, OE, E, Pre-E I/P, 8am - dressage; 10am - show jumping; 12pm - cross country. Start times available at [www.eventingnews.com](http://www.eventingnews.com).

- 4) STABLING:** \$35 / stall per night on grounds – very limited basis. Initial bedding provided. Others off site. Stalls are on a first come, first serve basis. Enter early if you require stabling. Negative Coggins Test required within 12 months if stabling.
- 5) DRESSAGE:** All divisions –Test 1 (P-20X60 All others 20x40) Sand or grass footing Dressage arenas have been worked and stone picked
- 6) CROSS COUNTRY:** OI -3000@ 550m/min P -3,000m @ 520mpm , T - 2500m @ 450mpm; PT - 2000m @ 400mpm; Entry – 1500m @ 350mpm; Pre-E - 1200 @ 300mpm. **Please Note: Pre- Entry and Entry Cross Country will now be timed and penalized.** Terrain: Rolling sandy footing. All levels inviting and well built.
- 7) AWARDS:**.. Ribbons to 10th place.

Turn left to first farm on right (#2465). From Hwy 400, take Horseshoe Valley Road East past Coulsen to 10th Oro (at Jarratt). Turn right on 10th. Farm 3km on left (#2465).
- 10) OTHER INFORMATION:** Vet on call with tec on grounds, farrier and medical on grounds. Refreshments available on grounds. Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
